## **RRM CANADA DAILY BRIEF**

## Key findings:

- RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem during the period of September 07.
- · RRM Canada assesses the majority of English and French-language content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites.
- CPC media and officials continue to comment on Minister Garneau calling the arrest of the two Michaels arbitrary detention.

#### On our radar

### User engagement with French and English-language online media

- The majority of French and English-language stories shared on Facebook, Twitter and Reddit for September 07 originated from recognizable Canadian media outlets.
- The topics with the most user engagement for the reporting period include:
  - News stories about spectators throwing rocks at the PM at an LPC campaign event in London, ON received considerable user interest on all major platforms (over 17K engagements overall).
  - A Quebec Catholic School Board's decision to remove 5,000 children's books that portray First Nations peoples in racist or stereotypical portrayals received considerable user interest on all major platforms (nearly 4.0K engagements).

#### User engagement with Sinophone online media

- Following comments by Minister Garneau that the two Michaels were "arbitrarily detained" and that Canada "strongly condemns the
  lack of a transparent legal process", Chinese Communist Party (CCP) media published a statement from PRC ambassador Cong Peiwu
  that the Minister's remarks were a "gross interference in China's judicial sovereignty and a serious violation of the spirit of the rule of
  law."
  - RRM Canada reported that the statement could be found on WeChat, but can now confirm that it was published across all major Chinese platforms (Weibo and Douyin) during the same time interval on September 06.
  - o On Weibo, CCP newswire service *Xinhua* <u>published a hashtag</u> called #The PRC Embassy in Canada counters the erroneous statement made by the Canadian Foreign Minister #. (#驻加拿大使馆就加外长错误声明发表谈话#)
  - The hashtag briefly trended on the platform. According to Weibo's in-site analytics, the hashtag was seen over 821K times.
  - A similar hashtag published by the People's Daily also trended on the platform, and was viewed 46M times.
  - Users who click on the hashtag are brought to a Weibo landing page to see Cong's full response to Minister Morneau's remarks
  - The response was shared by some of Weibo's most subscribed CCP media accounts, including Xinhua News (86M followers) and Reference News (21M followers).
  - Many of the posts included the following statement from Cong: "Nationality is not a 'talisman' to escape legal sanctions; China
    is a country governed by the rule of law, and anyone who violates the law in China will certainly be sanctioned by Chinese law."
  - o Cong does not comment on GE44, or name any other parties or candidates in his statement.
- Most of the most-viewed stories on WeChat for September 07 originated from recognizable Chinese-Canadian WeChat news accounts.
- An apparently false rumor that CPC leader Erin O'Toole would "ban WeChat" if elected has not been re-shared by WeChat news
  accounts since September 02.

- The Global Times and the People's Daily reported on the PM being struck by rocks at an LPC rally. The writers did not add any color commentary to the report, and did not discuss any other candidates or parties.
  - The GT WeChat account is the most subscribed on the platform, and the article received high levels of user interest (100K+ views).

## User engagement with Russophone online media

- There were no high-engagement posts from Canadian Russian-language media outlets for the September 07 reporting period
- Topics of interest in global Russian-language media include:
  - o An article about Canada lifting travel restrictions for fully vaccinated individuals.
  - o An <u>article</u> from a Russian "grey news site" that notes the volume of mortgage loans issued in Canada has exceeded the size of the economy
  - o A Russian tabloid story reporting on recent developments in Dagestan
  - o An investigatory report by Ukrainian media looking at who the Ministry of Defense awards personal pistols to and why
  - o A Ukrainian media report about the dismantling of two monuments in Russian-occupied Crimea
  - There is also some reports from Russian state media looking at GE44-related news stories, such as coverage of spectators throwing stones at the LPC leader
