#### **RRM CANADA DAILY BRIEF**

## **Key findings:**

- RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem during the period of August 18
- RRM Canada assesses the majority of content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites.
- RRM Canada identified an article from the Global Times that called on users to "Co-sign our petition! Request Canada to release [Meng Wanzhou]!" The Global Times likely timed the release of the petition with Meng's 1000<sup>th</sup> day of in detention in Canada, and not the federal election. The petition has received high levels of engagement on the Chinese platform WeChat, but little engagement on Twitter, Facebook or Reddit. # Notes on WeChat engagement

• Generally, the top-ranking Canadian politics stories on WeChat originate from locally-run accounts, such as 51.ca, SuperLife, BC Bay and York BBS. The top four Canadian politics stories for August 18 all originate from the Global Times and feature the petition to Amb. Barton demanding the release of Meng Wanzhou.

#### On our radar:

## **Global Times** article and petition:

- The Global Times' WeChat account posted an <u>article</u> calling on users to sign a petition that "demands Canada release Chinese citizen Meng Wanzhou." The petition is likely intended for both a domestic and foreign audience, and is available in both English and Chinese. The Global Times later shared the <u>petition</u> on Weibo, Facebook and Twitter.
- The article <a href="headline">headline</a> directs users to a clear call of action "Co-sign the petition! request Canada to release [Meng Wanzhou!]" It then directs users to a separate HTML web page hosted outside the WeChat platform. In general, news articles within the WeChat subscription service are hard to share outside of the platform's ecosystem. The petition is likely hosted on a regular HTML web page to encourage users to share it with others.
- Users who wish to sign the petition only have to click a button in the centre of the page. The user does not have to provide their name or any other identifying information. Underneath the "sign the petition" button, a user is prompted to share the website URL on Facebook or Twitter.
- There is a counter that displays how many users have signed the petition. At the time of writing, there were 7.8 million signees.
- The Global Times Twitter account (1.8 million followers) shared the petition a number of times, and tweeted: "We need your vote! After nearly 1,000 days, Chinese citizen #MengWanzhou is still under detention in #Canada due to political persecution by #US. Come sign this online petition to call for Meng's immediate release."
- As of writing, the petition has received a total engagement of 13K (including likes, comments and shares) on Facebook, Twitter and Reddit; a number of high-followers accounts have shared the petition, including the <u>People's Daily Facebook page</u> (2.7 million followers) and <u>Zhang Heqing</u>, counselor at the PRC embassy to Pakistan (74K followers).
- The People's Daily Weibo account has shared the petition with its 80 million followers. The post has since been shared 21K times.
- The following is an excerpt from the English petition:
- "Your government, which labels itself internationally as a country that "values human rights," is flatteringly compliant in the face of such blatant political persecution of a Chinese citizen by the US government. What is even more outrageous is, despite the overwhelming evidence that Meng presented to show how the US was lying, Canada still pushed forward with so-called extradition procedures.
  As an accomplice in the case, the Canadian government should be held liable for aiding the US persecute a Chinese citizen for political purposes. Therefore, as the 1,000 days approach after Meng was illegally detained in Canada, the Global Times has launched a campaign to invite netizens from China and the rest of the world to join in the appeal against the ugly acts of the Canadian government, which is acting as an accomplice of the US government to persecute a Chinese citizen, demanding the immediate and unconditional release of Meng. We would like to ask you to convey our concerns to your government truthfully."
