RRM CANADA DAILY BRIEF

Key findings:

- RRM Canada did not observe any clear evidence of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem on September 14. However, Chinese State media continues to take interest in GE44 in general and the perceived China policies of the Conservative Party of Canada in particular.
- RRM Canada assesses the majority of English and French-language content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites.
- Chinese Communist Party media outlets continue to share an article on Chinese news aggregators that the Conservatives "almost want to cut diplomatic relations with China."
 - o The volume of articles on this topic continue to increase, but it is not clear what levels of engagement these articles receive from users and what audiences are being targeted.
 - o For example, during the Sept 14 reporting period, the media outlets who shared the articles, including <u>Strait Consumer Digest</u>, and <u>MNW.net</u>, are based in Fujian province, and report primarily on cross-strait news and issues. It appears these outlets are sharing the GT article because it suggests the Conservative Party would pursue "greater political cooperation with Taiwan." It is unlikely that Canadians would see these articles, and are likely produced for news consumers based in Fujian province, Southern China.

On our radar

User engagement with French and English-language online media

- The majority of French and English-language stories shared on Facebook, Twitter and Reddit for September 14 originated from recognizable Canadian media outlets.
- Some notable article during the reporting period include:
 - Broadbent Institute media arm Press Progress claims that an internal memo from Health Canada tacitly approved of the NDP's proposed dental care plan, and that it would address "significant barriers" for uninsured Canadians. The article received considerable interest from users (3.6K engagements overall)
 - Media outlet Canadaland <u>questioned</u> the Institute's claim that it has "no formal link" with the federal NDP and that PressProgress articles "run parallel with NDO talking points."
 - o The Broadbent Institute is not registered as a third party for GE44 with Elections Canada.

User engagement with Sinophone online media

- The most-viewed stories on WeChat for September 14 originated from a mix of recognizable Chinese-Canadian WeChat news accounts and CCP media outlets.
- Chinese Communist Party media outlets continue to share an article on Chinese news aggregators that the Conservatives "almost want
 to cut diplomatic relations with China." The volume of articles on this topic continue to increase, however, it is not clear what levels of
 engagement these articles receive from users. Data analytics tools BuzzSumo and Crowdtangle reveal no significant user engagement
 on Facebook, Twitter or Reddit.
 - The articles repeat the content and tone of the original Global Times piece on the topic, and do not add any new commentary on GE44.
 - o RRM Canada did not discover the article being shared on WeChat or Weibo -- the two main platforms for Chinese internet users to share and comment on news stories.
 - The media outlets who shared the articles, including <u>Strait Consumer Digest</u>, and <u>MNW.net</u>, are based in Fujian province, and report primarily on cross-strait news and issues. It appears these outlets are sharing the GT article because it suggests the Conservative Party would pursue "greater political cooperation with Taiwan."
- The Global Times reported on an incident at a BC campaign event where the LPC leader retorted to a protester "isn't there a hospital
 you should be going to bother right now?" after said protester insulted the LPC leader's wife.

- The Global Times' claims the retort "did not endear the public, with many web users finding the response inappropriate" and that it may "indirectly encourage protesters to continue to make trouble." The GT author screengrabs three tweets from various Twitter users who say they disapprove of Justin Trudeau's retort. The article received some user attention (24K views).
- Xinhua (26M followers) and the China Daily (34M followers) Douyin accounts shared two popular videos about Canada "ordering China Mobile to withdraw from the Canadian telecom market on so-called 'national security' grounds."
 - The videos did not link the order to GE44.
 - The videos received considerable engagement (over 185k likes and 5.2K shares combined).

User engagement with Russophone online media

- There were no high-engagement posts from Canadian Russian-language media outlets for the September 14 reporting period
- Topics of interest in global Russian-language media include:
 - o Russian state media outlets (*RT* and *Rossiyskaya Gazeta*) shared news stories about an Ontario Catholic School Board's decision to burn "prohibited" books.
 - Russian mainstream media site RBC Daily reported on the Governor of Moscow closing down a hostel after migrant tenants'
 were accused of murdering a local woman.
 - o RBC Daily reported on Putin's self-isolation due to the spread of COVID among those working closely with him
 - Ukrainian opposition media News One <u>carried</u> a story dealing with an ATIP to disclose available information about President Zelensky's itinerary during his recent U.S. trip, as well as information about a proposed "Transformation Plan" for the Ukrainian economy.
