	■ IAS Comment: One of the objectives of the United Front Work Department (UFWD) is to influence foreign politicians and government officials into taking specific stances on China's issues of interest. Besides funding, the UFWD is also likely to offer candidates logistical support, favourable media coverage, and endorsements. The UFWD's extensive network of quasi-official and local community and interest groups allows it to obfuscate communication and the flow of funds between Canadian targets and Chinese officials. These FI efforts are likely to be more persistent and pervasive in future elections; under President Xi Jinping, the UFWD has seen an expansion in resources and improved coordination. (S/CEO)
