The had initially contacted the OCIU to report that just discovered in his phone news from a Chinese tv station (fairchildtv.com). A segment of the news video included seemingly customary electoral activity inside a polling station. The was also concerned about potential foreign interference in Canadian elections.

Investigation:

2019-10-15: Email to advising her that we would be looking into this matter.



In relation to the present matter, there is no indication that a candidate's representative filmed the inside the polling station. Rather, the film material appears to have been gathered by a media outlet for purpose of media broadcast. As a consequence, there is no second 136 (4) violation here.

The video itself was broadcast on www.fairchildtv.com/news. This webpage's About Fairchild Television sets out the following information:

Founded in 1993 as one of the subsidiaries of the multi-media conglomerate Fairchild Media Group, Fairchild Television was the first Chinese media corporation to operate nationwide in Canada. With the head office located in Vancouver, Fairchild Television has set up two other regional offices in Toronto and Calgary. In order to better serve the increasing number of Chinese immigrants, Fairchild Television constantly works towards bringing viewers the latest and most popular Asian dramas, entertainment programs, variety shows, investigative reports and news and current affairs programs. Through Fairchild Television, Chinese immigrants can be updated on the latest news and cultural trends of Asia every minute of the day. Fairchild Television also puts its best efforts into producing local daily news and other programming to assist new immigrants in quickly adapting to and immerging into Canadian culture and lifestyle. Fairchild Television also takes pride in its annual productions of variety shows such as Miss Chinese Vancouver and Miss Chinese Toronto Pageants, and New Talent Singing Awards. Through both satellite and cable services, Chinese Canadians are able to enjoy over twenty hours of high-quality Chinese television programming daily.

My perusing other portions of this website were consistent with this mission statement. The content is Chinese but a translation button allows for easy and immediate English translation.

2019-11-19: Request to to view this video and provide the gist of its content and message. The has some working knowledge of Chinese language. After viewing the video, reported that,

Fairchild TV est un poste de té lé vision canadien en langue cantonaise. La majorité du contenu est en cantonais sauf une dame qui parle brièvement en mandarin. C'est é crit en chinois traditionnel (en Chine continentale, on utilise le chinois simplifié).

En terme de message, on parle d'exercer son droit de vote et on explique comment le faire (un peu comme l'information qu'É fournit) – c'est vraiment le message principal de la vidé o. On parle à des é lecteurs, mais c'est par rapport au vote, pas par rapport à un parti en particulier. On dit aussi que beaucoup d'é lecteurs envoient des messages dans les groupes d'amis (le nom utilisé est celui des groupes dans WeChat) pour dire qu'ils ont dé jàvoté . Il y a aussi une ré fé rence à une confé rence de presse d'une organisation canadienne. Dans la confé rence, on semble encourager les é lecteurs à penser à la situation actuelle à Hong Kong lorsqu'ils feront leur choix. Je ne suis pas certaine de la date de diffusion, mais la date de l'é lection mentionné e est celle de cette anné e.

The complainant had also expressed some concern about foreign influence. The investigation supports that Fairchild Television is a Canadian-based media service which provides services to new Chinese immigrants and inform them about local and international news. As such, there is no substance to support foreign influence.

Conclusion:

Our preliminary inquiries failed to identify any activity in breach of the CEA. File recommended for closing.

I have delved further into your complaint and have consulted with our in-house legal counsel.

I was informed that the *Canada Elections Act* includes a provision aimed specifically at candidates' representative, but no one else dealing with the taking of photographs or videos at a polling station. Specifically, section 136 (4) reads as follows.

- (4) A candidate's representative
- (a) shall not take any photograph or make any audio or video recording at a polling station; and
- (b) shall not, if he or she uses a communications device at a polling station, impede any elector from exercising their right to vote or violate the secrecy of the vote.

This being said, except for the aforementioned section and other prohibitions in relation to ballots, the Act per se does not prohibit the taking of photographs or video inside a polling station.

As for your second point, the provisions surrounding foreign interference are quite complex. However, there are a number of elements – primarily those that help foster a healthy debate – that are not considered an offence under the Act. For example, foreigners are free to express an opinion about the outcome or desired outcome of the election; make a statement encouraging electors to vote or not to vote for a candidate or a registered party in the election; or share an editorial, speech, interview, column, letter, commentary or news.

Additionally, in relation to the current matter, the video originated from and was broadcast by Fairchild Television, a Canadian-based media service which provides services to new Chinese immigrants and informs them about local and international news. As such, there is no substance to support foreign influence.

Given these findings, we concluded that the circumstances as described do not contravene any provision of the Act and, as such, cannot be pursued by our Office.
