Social Media Monitoring Report: August 31, 5pm – September 1, 5pm, 2021

Observations principales / Key observations

- Volume: Last 24h: 901; Previous 7 days average: 1.16K posts/day; Previous 30 days average: 1.29K posts/day; pre-campaign average: 100 posts/day
- The same topics and narratives from the last few days are persisting; the most notable elements are vote by mail - including comparisons to the U.S. - and concerns about masks and vaccination in polling places. The petition to restore campus voting continues to be shared but the topic is losing momentum for now.
- Main news elements likely to drive the election conversation are Ontario's introduction of vaccine passports and blaming the delay for a national solution on an "unnecessary election," as well as the decision by the CCE to dismiss a CPC complaint about an edited video posted to Twitter.

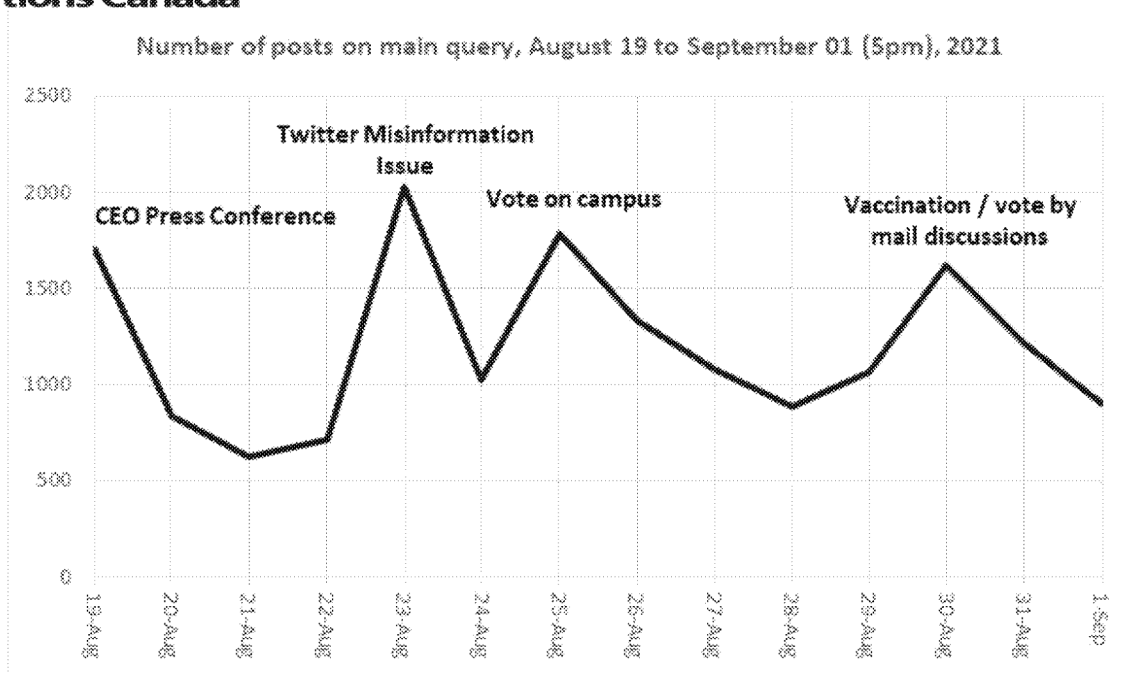

Éléments sous observation / On the radar

Elections Commissioner rules Twitter video did not represent an offence

On September 1st the OCCE dismissed a complaint filed by the CPC arguing that a Liberal MP had posted an edited video on Twitter that they believe constituted misinformation (Twitter labelled the video as having been manipulated). The Commissioner determined that "no offence has been committed under the act" by posting the video. While the news is still recent, it is expected that negative reactions will come and might include conflating the roles of EC and the OCCE, or claiming that EC/OCCE are partisan in favour of the PLC. Given the OCCE ruling, a number of social media users have accused Twitter of foreign interference for tagging the video.

- *Elections Canada is expecting a flood of mail-in ballots. So far that hasn't happened* – (Total shares: 36 / Total engagement: 464)
- *Anticipated flood of mail-in ballots during pandemic hasn't materialized so far* – (Total shares: 11 / Total engagement: 262)
- *This Toronto senior hoped to vote in the federal election by mail. She was 'shocked' to learn she had to apply to do so* (Total shares: 25 / Total engagement: 101)

Faits saillants sur les médias sociaux / Social media highlights

The familiar narrative that Elections Canada is going to 'rig the election' with machines and mail-in ballots because EC is partisan or corrupt continues unabated. On one end, this narrative continues to find fertile ground with people who think that the pandemic is a hoax and that lockdowns and vaccine passports are designed to control society (including to establish globalism in 'the great reset' and 'push people to mail-in-ballots' so that 'the cabal' can solidify their power. Despite the extreme origins of this narrative, it has been repeated enough on social media that some people are questioning aspects of the pandemic election. On the other side of the spectrum, some Canadians are choosing to vote by mail because they fear the chaos of the 2020 U.S. election, the spread of the Delta variant, and trust EC enough to run the process. We continue to see misinterpretations from social media users who believe that any ballots received in Ottawa after election day will still be counted.

The frequently reshared warning for Canadians in BC to vote in person before the September 13 vaccine pass system is implemented continues to spread on social media. Even if people are suspicious of the rumour that they won't be able to vote in person after the 13th, they still share the message online in comments sections out of an abundance of caution and tell unvaccinated people to vote early 'just to be sure.'
