Subject: National Security Law relating to Hong Kong

Dear Member of the House of Commons:

The Chinese Benevolent Association of Vancouver and the Hong Kong Canadians on Hong Kong Situation Association, in unity with other Chinese community associations and individuals across Canada have issued a joint statement in support of Hong Kong's implementation of the National Security Law.
